Ukrainian Day 2011-"Kanada-Ukraina 120: Groundbreakers-Nation-Builders-Trailblazers"

EDMONTON-The Ukrainian Canadian Congress-Alberta Provincial Council (UCC-APC), partnering with the Ukrainian Cultrual Heritage Village, invites everyone to attend the annual Ukrainian Day Festival at the Ukrainian Village on Sunday August 7, and celebrate all things Ukrainian! This years' theme of "Kanada-Ukraina 120: Groundbreakers-Nation-Builders-Trailblazers" will be in celebration of the 120th anniversary of Ukrainian settlement in Canada, and will set the tone of the event reflecting both the cultural history and current reality of Alberta's Ukrainian Canadian Community.

UCC-APC is also honoured to announce that the Honourable Premier Ed Stelmach, the first Alberta Premier of Ukrainian ancestry, will attend this year's Ukrainian Day as a special guest. Other federal, provincial, and municipal representatives will also be in attendance.

This event, which draws over 5,000 visitors annually, will commence at 9AM, and end at 5PM. Featured will be a concert showcase that features Ukrainian talent form east-central Alberta, a 'Taste of Ukraine' food fair, children's activities, Centenary Pioneer recognition, a tribute to veterans, and a community art show and sale, and more.

The annual presentation of The Michael Luchkovich Award will also be made at Ukrainian Day. This award is given to former parliamentarians of Ukrainian descent for significant contribution and dedication to the betterment of all Canadians. The Honorable Mr. Justice Allen Sulatycky, this year's recipient, was integral in the establishment of the Ukrainian Cultural Heritage Village, the location of the annual Ukrainian Day. His storied career includes time in law, public service, and involmment with extensive community efforts.

Admission rates to the Ukrainian Heritage Village are \$9 for adults, \$7 for seniors (age 65+), \$4 for youth (age 7-17), and free for children age six or under. There is a special \$20 admission rate for families. Tickets can be purchased at the Village's entrance.
