

UCC-APC Ukrainian Christmas Card Contest

The Ukrainian Canadian Congress – Alberta Provincial Council is holding a kids' art contest to select designs for our annual Christmas Card. Enter your children's art with the theme, “Ukrainian Christmas” before November 12th, 2022 to win one of three prizes:

- **Category 1:** Ages 5-9 (One winner- \$50 e-gift card of the winner's choice)
- **Category 2:** Ages 10-14 (One winner- \$50 e-gift card of the winner's choice)
- **Category 3:** Ages 15-18 (One Winner- \$50 e-gift card of the winner's choice)

The Christmas cards will be printed for use in our Christmas Newsletter, which is sent to contacts across Alberta. Winners and runners up will be displayed on our social media and during UCC-APC holiday events. Winners will be selected by a panel of judges based on interpretation, creativity, design quality, and overall impression.

To enter, send your artwork to community@uccab.ca, together with the artist's name, city, and contact number.

Please read further for full contest rules:

Full Contest Rules

1. Description of contest: The purpose of the UCC-APC Ukrainian Christmas Card Contest is to select three winning designs created by participating children, one from each age group. The winning designs will be printed and reproduced by the Ukrainian Canadian Congress - Alberta Provincial Council as a greeting card design to be mailed together with our holiday letter. Eligible contestants are invited to draw a card that depicts their interpretation of the theme “Ukrainian Christmas”.

2. Eligibility: All children between the ages of 6 and 18 as of November 12, 2022 and who reside in Alberta are eligible to participate. Children do not have to be Ukrainian to enter. Newcomer children are welcome to enter. The immediate family members of employees of the Ukrainian Canadian Congress are not eligible to enter.

3. How to enter:

- A. Please email a scanned copy of the art to community@uccab.ca. Art can also be mailed or dropped off at our office: **#8, 8103 – 127 Avenue Edmonton, AB, Canada, T5C 1R9.**
- B. Pencil, pen, crayon, colour markers and paints are permitted. Computer generated artwork will also be accepted. Artwork must be original to the child entering the contest, not previously published and not copied.
- C. Only one entry per child. All entries must be received by **23:59:59 November 12, 2022.**
- D. Upon entry, all cards, artwork and related intellectual property rights, including but not limited to copyright, become the sole property of the Canadian UNICEF Committee, without compensation to entrant. Upon entry each participating contestant irrevocably waives all moral rights respecting the cards and artwork.
- E. Entries may, throughout the contest and thereafter, be distributed, used, exhibited, donated, sold, auctioned, and/or displayed by the Ukrainian Canadian Congress - Alberta Provincial Council. (Including, but not limited to, reproduction and display on UCC-APC website) and will be disposed of at the discretion of UCC-APC, which rights are granted by an entrant to the Sponsors upon entry, all without notice or compensation to entrant.

4. Winner selection: Entries will be judged by a jury of representatives of Ukrainian Canadian Congress- Alberta Provincial Council. Based on the artwork submitted to our competitions, they will be judged based on the following elements of artistic expression:

- **Interpretation:** The clarity of the theme “Ukrainian Christmas”.
- **Creativity:** The originality of the artwork.
- **Design Quality:** Quality of artistic composition and overall design based on the theme.
- **Overall impression of the art**

The winners will be selected and notified by phone and/or email. All decisions of the judges are final. Odds of winning based on number of entries received.

5. Prizes:

- Three finalists will be selected from the entries, one from each of the following age group:
 - **Category 1:** Ages 5-9 (One winner- \$50 e-gift card of the winner’s choice)
 - **Category 2:** Ages 10-14 (One winner- \$50 e-gift card of the winner’s choice)
 - **Category 3:** Ages 15-18 (One Winner- \$50 e-gift card of the winner’s choice)
- One prize will be awarded to each winner in each age group. The prize consists of one \$50 (fifty dollar) e-gift card of the winner’s choice. The gift card choice is subject to approval by the Ukrainian Canadian Congress-Alberta Provincial Council. The prize will be sent to the winner via email. In accordance with Canadian law, no charitable receipt for income tax purposes can be issued to the finalists. All prizes will be donated by the Ukrainian Canadian Congress-Alberta Provincial Council. All prizes are non-transferable and nonrefundable. No prize substitutions or redemptions.
- The grand prize-winning greeting cards will be printed, reproduced and sold by the Ukrainian Canadian Congress - Alberta Provincial Council and is subject to interpretation and modification. The winning greeting cards will be sent out as our yearly Christmas Card as part of a campaign to collect donations for UCC-APC. Without any further compensation to the grand prize winner, Ukrainian Canadian Congress - Alberta Provincial Council will each have the right to reproduce and sell the greeting cards and also the right to use reproductions of the grand prize-winning card as the Ukrainian Canadian Congress - Alberta Provincial Council official corporate greeting card for the 2022-2023 holiday season and in connection with future promotional campaigns.

6. Additional terms and conditions:

- a. Contest subject to all federal, provincial and local laws and regulations. This contest is void where prohibited. Applicable taxes, if any, are the responsibility of the winners.
- b. Entry constitutes agreement with all of the foregoing rules and terms, and also constitutes permission to use the winner’s and parent’s or legal guardian’s name, likeness, contest card entry and information contained therein, artwork, statements, quotes, testimonials, photographs, and name of hometown for promotional purposes, including but not limited to posting of such information and reproduction and display of the winner’s card on the Sponsors’ websites, except where prohibited by law. Failure to comply with the contest rules may result in the entrant’s disqualification.
- c. UCC-APC is not responsible for: (1) lost, stolen, illegible, torn, damaged, late, incomplete or misdirected entries; (2) telephone, electronic, hardware or software program, network, Internet or computer malfunctions, failures or difficulties; and (3) any condition caused by events beyond the control of the Sponsors which may cause the contest or the awarding of prizes to be disrupted or impractical of being completed. Sponsors reserve the right to suspend and/or cancel the contest should causes beyond their control interfere with the administration, security or proper conduct of the contest. Sponsors will only collect personal information which is sufficient to determine and identify the grand prize winner and will contact the grand prize winner’s parent or guardian only. The Sponsors will not retain any personal information following the conclusion of the contest other than that required specifically for the due operation of the contest. The Sponsors will not use the personal information collected herein for any other purpose.
- d. This contest is offered only in Alberta.
- e. The collection and use of personal information of the entrants and their parents and/or legal guardians by the Sponsors will be subject to the Ukrainian Canadian Congress - Alberta Provincial Council Privacy Policy.
